15.3 Medical and safety information

Citizens of the EU/EEA–countries* will receive emergency medical care paying the same patient charge as Swedish citizens, whilst in Sweden.

Citizens from these countries must provide an E 111-form, EU card or corresponding document verifying that the person is covered by health insurance, when the medical care is required and should obtain this form before leaving their home country. Citizens from the Nordic countries are not required to provide the E 111-form.

*(Austria, Belgium, Bulgaria, Cyprus, the Czech Republic, Croatia, Denmark, Estonia, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Hungary, Iceland, Italy, Latvia, Liechtenstein, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malta, the Netherlands, Norway, Poland, Portugal, Republic of Ireland, Romania, Switzerland, Slovakia, Slovenia, Spain, Sweden and the United Kingdom).

Besides the EU/EAA-countries Sweden has an agreement with the following countries which guarantees the citizens emergency medical care at the same patient charge as Swedish citizens, whilst in Sweden: Algeria and Australia.

Competitors from these countries must also provide an E 111-form, EU card or corresponding document verifying that the person is covered by health insurance. Citizens in other countries than mentioned above have to pay the total cost of treatment plus the patient charge.
